

**SCHEME OF SERVICE SPECIFIED UNDER REGULATION 15 OF THE
PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION REGULATIONS**

- Ministry:** Health and Quality of Life
- Post:** Student Midwife
- Salary:** Rs 9,200 x 200 – 9,600 (09 16 18)
- Effective Date:** 12 July 2010
- Age Limit:** Between 18 and 35 years of age
- Qualifications:**
- A. A Cambridge School Certificate with credit in at least five subjects including Biology or Human and Social Biology or Chemistry or Physics obtained on one certificate or Passes not below Grade C in at least five subjects including Biology or Human and Social Biology or Chemistry or Physics obtained on one certificate at the General Certificate of Education “Ordinary Level” or an equivalent qualification acceptable to the Public Service Commission.

B. Candidates should be computer literate.

Candidates should produce written evidence of knowledge claimed.

Training: Student Midwives will be required to follow such theoretical and practical training including on-the-job training in all aspects of the work of a Midwife for a period of at least two years, as arranged and approved by the Ministry of Health and Quality of Life.

On successful completion of the training, which includes the passing of an examination and obtention of the Certificate of Competency in Midwifery, Student Midwives will become eligible for full registration as Midwife with the Nursing Council in accordance with legislation in force in Mauritius. On registration, they will be considered for appointment to the grade of Midwife, as and when vacancies occur.

NOTE

Student Midwives may be required to undergo practical training during the day and at night, on weekdays, Saturdays, Sundays, Public Holidays and officially declared cyclone days.
