Qualifications: By promotion on the basis of experience and merit of Dispensers reckoning at least five years' service in the grade.

Duties:

1. To be responsible to the head of the institution concerned through the Principal Dispenser or Pharmacist/Senior Pharmacist and ultimately to the Chief Dispenser for:-
 - (i) performing the duties of a Dispenser in a Senior capacity;
 - (ii) operating pharmaceutical equipment;
 - (iii) storekeeping of drugs, medicines, sterile products, ingredients, equipment and surgical dressings in a pharmacy;
 - (iv) supplying, against store form, compound medicine to institutions within the catchment area;
 - (v) ensuring the proper keeping of records on the issue of expensive drugs and submitting monthly return thereof in the absence of a Pharmacist/Senior Pharmacist;
 - (vi) supervising junior staff and assisting in their on the job training;
 - (vii) opening and closing of the pharmacy; and
2. To perform such cognate duties as may be assigned.

NOTE

Senior Dispensers should work on a shift system including week-ends and public holidays, whenever required.
