- Duties:** To be responsible to the Principal Health Engineering Assistant for the following:
1. To plan, control and supervise the work of the Health Engineering Assistants in the region.
  2. To collaborate with the Health Inspectorate Cadre in the region regarding sanitary engineering and environmental pollution control.
  3. To examine applications and drawings for industrial sites and buildings, hotels and parcelling of lands for health clearance, and to carry out on-site inspections, where appropriate, and report thereon.
  4. To carry out industrial hygiene surveys and monitor working conditions in industries in collaboration with the Occupational Health Unit.
  5. To monitor pollution in relation to air, noise and land and water environmental hazards according to established procedures and report thereon.
  6. To deliver talks in connection with health education programmes and assist in the training of Trainee Health Inspectors and other officers on aspects of environmental health.
