

**SCHEME OF SERVICE SPECIFIED UNDER REGULATION 15 OF THE
PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION REGULATIONS**

- Ministry:** Health and Wellness
- Post:** Ambulance Care Attendant (on shift)
- Salary:** Rs 24,245 x 300 – 26,945 x 320 – 28,865 x 350 – 30,965 x 400 – 31,765 x 425 – 33,040 x 560 – 34,720 (24 027 056)
- Effective Date:** 25 February 2026
- Qualifications:** By selection from among employees on the permanent and pensionable establishment of the Ministry who –
- (a) possess the Certificate of Primary Education or the Primary School Achievement Certificate; and
 - (b) reckon at least three years' service in the Ministry.

NOTE 1

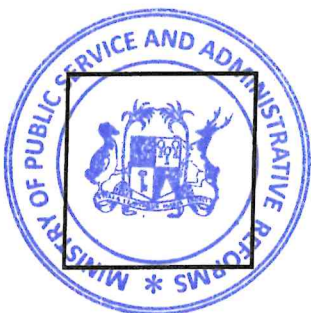
In the absence of employees possessing the qualification at (a) above, consideration will be given to those who show proof of being literate and who reckon at least three years' service in the Ministry.

NOTE 2

Selected candidates will be appointed in a temporary capacity for a period of six months in the first instance and will be required to follow a course in First Aid, as approved and arranged by the Ministry. On completion of the temporary period including the successful completion of the course and on being favourably reported upon, they will be considered for appointment as Ambulance Care Attendant (on shift) in a substantive capacity.

- Duties:**
1. To be responsible to the Hospital Administrative Assistant through the Hospital Executive Assistant (on shift) in the performance of the following duties –
 - (a) handling the sick, injured and the convalescents who enter and leave an ambulance;
 - (b) assisting in the conveyance of patients under normal conditions and also during pandemic situations to and from an ambulance;

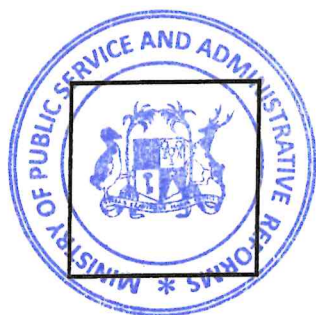

- (c) maintaining the ambulance in clean condition at all reasonable times both inside and outside by following the necessary disinfection protocols and making use of cleaning/spraying disinfectants to prevent infection and insect infestation; and
 - (d) assisting the driver in carrying out simple maintenance tasks and effecting minor repairs in ambulance.
2. To inform the Hospital Executive Assistant (on shift) and the Hospital Administrative Assistant on the renewal of fire extinguishers found in the ambulance/van.
 3. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the Ambulance Care Attendant (on shift) in the roles ascribed to him.

Note

Ambulance Care Attendants (on shift) will be required to work on shift covering a 24-hour service including Saturdays, Sundays and Public Holidays and during cyclonic periods and other natural calamities in accordance with the protocol of the Ministry.
