- Qualifications:**
- A. Cambridge Higher School Certificate or Passes in at least two subjects obtained on one certificate at the General Certificate of Education “Advanced Level” or an equivalent qualification acceptable to the Public Service Commission.
- B. Candidates should be computer literate.

Candidates should produce written evidence of knowledge claimed.

- Duties:**
1. To carry out traffic management, road safety and transport surveys, campaigns and studies for evaluation.
 2. To carry out traffic counts (both manual and automatic) and also install and remove automatic counters or any similar equipment and collect data therefrom.
 3. To compile and prepare data on traffic surveys carried out by Traffic Census Officers and input these into computers.
 4. To carry out parking and road marking surveys, including parking inventory.
 5. To carry out traffic engineering surveys including origin and destination surveys.
 6. To inspect traffic lights and traffic signs.
 7. To perform site visits before conducting drone surveys.

8. To assist in –
 - (i) calibration and maintenance of drones;
 - (ii) the operational activities of drone surveys; and
 - (iii) retrieving data after conducting drone surveys.
9. To provide training to police officers on how to input road crash data on internet Microcomputer Accident Analysis Package (iMAAP) software.
10. To install and update iMAAP software on tablets provided by Traffic Management and Road Safety Unit at Police Stations on a regular basis.
11. To ensure that all road accident data including GPS Coordinates are correctly input on iMAAP software.
12. To query for missing crash data for road accident recorded on iMAAP software provided by Statistical Officers.
13. To use ICT in the performance of his duties.
14. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the Traffic Census Officer in the roles ascribed to him.

Note

Traffic Census Officers are required to work at staggered hours and must report daily to office, either after or before site attendance.



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
