Qualifications: By selection from among Drivers on the permanent and pensionable establishment of the Ministry who possess a Goods Vehicle Driving Licence.

NOTE:

Selected candidates will be required to obtain a Service Vehicle Driving Licence for heavy units.

Duties:

1. To drive and operate heavy units such as excavators, dredgers, bulldozers, tico-cranes, rollers, heavy tractors, heavy mechanical units, skid loaders, bell loaders.
2. To carry out simple maintenance tasks including:
 - (a) washing and cleaning of cabin (exterior and interior) and chassis; and
 - (b) checking of radiator, engine oil pump, brake and clutch, master cylinders, wheel nuts for wheel tightness, etc
3. To effect minor repairs to the vehicles including changing of tyres.
4. To help, whenever required, the Mechanics when the vehicle or engine is under repairs.
