- 3. To keep a record of maintenance works carried out and to submit returns, as may be required.
- 4. To perform all IT related activities directly related to the job.
- 5. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from Electronic Technicians in the roles ascribed to them.

- 1. Electronic Technicians may be required to follow such theoretical, practical or on-the-job training courses, as may be approved and arranged.
