PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION REGULATIONS**

- Department:** Meteorological Services
- Post:** Meteorological Technician
- Salary:** Rs 16,400 x 325 – 17,700 x 375 – 19,575 x 475 – 21,950 x 625 – 23,200 x 775 – 32,500 x 925 – 35,275 QB 36,200 x 925 – 37,125 x 1,225 – 38,350 (19 035 069)
- Effective Date:** 13 February 2020
- Qualifications:** By appointment of Trainee Meteorological Technicians who have successfully completed their training including the obtention of a diploma in Meteorology from a recognised institution or an equivalent qualification acceptable to the Public Service Commission.
- Duties:**
1. To perform observations of the elements of weather including radiosonde ascents according to the World Meteorological Organisation requirements.
 2. To collect, archive and disseminate meteorological data/products.
 3. To upload meteorological products on the website.
 4. To plot synoptic and upper air charts.
 5. To operate radio transmitters and receivers for the collection and dissemination of meteorological data.
 6. To carry out maintenance of conventional Meteorological Instruments and assist in retrieving data from Automatic Weather Stations.
 7. To guide visitors and assist in awareness campaigns related to Meteorology.
 8. To use ICT in the performance of his duties.
 9. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the Meteorological Technician in the roles ascribed to him.

Note

1. Meteorological Technicians will be required to work on a shift, covering a 24-hour service including Saturdays, Sundays and Public Holidays, officially declared cyclone days and during extreme weather events in Mauritius and the Outer Islands of the Republic of Mauritius.
2. Meteorological Technicians may be required to work in any part of the Republic of Mauritius including Rodrigues and the Outer Islands (Agalega and St Brandon).
