- Department:** Meteorological Services
- Post:** Trainee Meteorologist
- Salary:** Rs 22,175 x 750 – 23,675 (19 47 49)
- Effective Date:** 29 September 2015
- Age Limit** Not more than 40 years of age
- Qualifications:** By selection from among officers who –
- (i) hold a substantive appointment in the Meteorological Technician Cadre or in the Meteorological Telecommunications Technician Cadre; and
 - (ii) possess a degree in Meteorology or Mathematics or Physics or Engineering or a Science degree, the major part of which should be Meteorology or Mathematics or Physics from a recognised institution or an equivalent qualification acceptable to the Public Service Commission.

NOTE

In the absence of qualified officers, by selection from among candidates who –


- (i) possess a degree in Meteorology or Mathematics or Physics or Engineering or a Science degree, the major part of which should be Meteorology or Mathematics or Physics from a recognised institution or an equivalent qualification acceptable to the Public Service Commission; and
- (ii) are computer literate.

Candidates should produce written evidence of knowledge claimed.

Training:

1. Trainee Meteorologists will be required to successfully complete a formal course abroad in weather forecasting leading to Class I Meteorologist standard or its equivalent acceptable to the Government of Mauritius and conforming to World Meteorological Organisation standards.
2. After successful completion of the formal course, Trainee Meteorologists will be required to follow a practical on-the-job training for a period of not less than six months. At the end of the training and on being favourably reported upon, Trainee Meteorologists will be eligible for appointment to the grade of Meteorologist.
