**Effective Date:** 12 July 2002

**Qualifications:** By promotion, on the basis of experience and merit, of officers in the grade of Probation Officer who:

- (i) reckon at least three years' service in a substantive capacity in the grade; and
- (ii) possess a Diploma in Social Work from a recognised institution or an equivalent qualification acceptable to the Public Service Commission.

**Duties:**

1. To supervise and co-ordinate the work of Probation Officers.
2. To prepare social enquiry reports:
  - (i) in civil cases relating to custody and access and related matters at the request of Supreme Court.
  - (ii) for the office of the Director of Public Prosecutions, the National Adoption Council, the Parole Board and the International Social Services.
3. To investigate into cases referred by the courts and other higher judicial instances and supervise parolees and aftercare cases.
4. To attend to throughcare cases at the Rehabilitation Youth Centre and Correctional Youth Centre and to Community Service Orders, as and when required.
5. To act as Warden of the Probation Hostel for Boys and/or Probation Home for Girls, whenever required.
6. To attend to persons having suicidal tendencies.
7. To perform such cognate duties as may be assigned.

**Note**

Senior Probation Officers may be required to attend duty after normal working hours including Sundays, Public Holidays and during emergencies.
