**Post:** Statistician/Senior Statistician  
**Salary:** Rs 15,500 x 500 – 17,000 x 600 – 20,000 x 800 – 28,000 x 1000 – 30,000 (20 46 66)  
**Effective Date:** 02 August 2005  
**Qualifications:** By selection from among candidates who:-

- A. possess the Cambridge Higher School Certificate with passes at Principal Level in at least two subjects including Mathematics obtained on one certificate or passes in at least two subjects including Mathematics obtained on one certificate at the General Certificate of Education "Advanced Level" or an equivalent qualification acceptable to the Public Service Commission;
- B. (i) have passed the Final Examinations of the United Kingdom Royal Statistical Society or of an equivalent recognised professional body acceptable to the Public Service Commission or have been exempted from the above examination;
- or
- (ii) possess a degree in Statistics from a recognised institution or an equivalent qualification acceptable to the Public Service Commission;
- C. reckon at least three years' experience in the field of Statistics obtained after qualification at B above; and
- D. have good organising, interpersonal and communication skills and show integrity of character.

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**Note**

Qualification at A above should have been obtained prior to qualification at B above. However, candidates who, as at 30 June 2003, did not possess the qualification at A above will also be considered provided they hold –

- (a) a Cambridge School Certificate or passes obtained on one certificate at the General Certificate of Education “Ordinary Level” either (i) in five subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any two subjects or (ii) in six subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any one subject or an equivalent qualification acceptable to the Public Service Commission; and
- (b) a Master’s Degree or a postgraduate diploma from a recognised institution in the field at B above or an equivalent qualification acceptable to the Public Service Commission.

Qualification at (a) under ‘Note’ should have been obtained prior to qualification at B above and at (b) under ‘Note’.

Candidates should produce written evidence of any experience claimed.

**Duties:**

- 1. To plan, organise and conduct surveys, including design of samples on drug-related issues.
- 2. To collect and compile all relevant data coming from the different stakeholders concerned with law enforcement and drug demand reduction agencies.
- 3. To apply advanced statistical methods and analyse statistical data.
- 4. To make forecasts and projections.
- 5. To prepare technical reports and provide statistical information support to the Narcotics Bureau.

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6. To evaluate, analyse, interpret and disseminate statistical data.
7. To develop and maintain an integrated system of statistics on narcotics and crime.
8. To develop social indicators with regard to narcotics and crime for monitoring social policies and programmes.
9. To perform such cognate duties as may be assigned.
