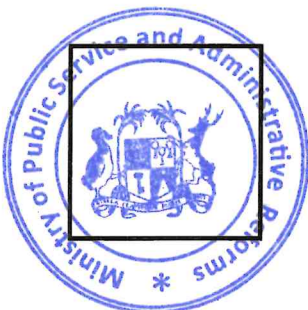
<u>Ministry:</u>	Energy and Public Utilities (Radiation Safety and Nuclear Security Authority)
<u>Post:</u>	Handy Worker (Special Class)
<u>Salary:</u>	Rs 14,225 x 250 – 15,225 x 260 – 17,825 x 275 – 18,925 x 300 – 19,525 x 325 – 21,475 x 375 – 22,225 x 400 – 23,025 (24 020 050)
<u>Effective Date:</u>	24 September 2025
<u>Qualifications:</u>	By selection from among serving employees on the permanent and pensionable establishment who – (a) possess the Certificate of Primary Education or the Primary School Achievement Certificate; and (b) reckon at least three years' service.

NOTE

In the absence of candidates possessing the qualification at (a) above, consideration will be given to those who show proof of being literate.

<u>Duties:</u>	1. To clean and upkeep all areas within the Radiation Safety and Nuclear Security Authority and its premises, including yards, floors, walls, windows, glass panes and corridors. 2. To perform gardening duties including trimming hedges, mowing lawns, pruning plants and cutting branches. 3. To clean and maintain the rainwater collection system. 4. To operate blower, pressure washer, hedge trimmer, pesticides sprayer and other cleaning equipment in accordance with prescribed safety measures. 5. To maintain cleaning equipment and personal protective equipment in good condition. 6. To carry out minor maintenance and painting work.

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7. To handle, carry, pack, load and unload store items, goods, furniture, equipment and materials.
8. To place and stow items in the storeroom and maintain them in an orderly manner.
9. To assist Drivers in effecting minor repairs of the vehicles including unmounting and changing of tyres and performing other ancillary works associated with the day-to-day running of the vehicles.
10. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the Handy Worker (Special Class) in the roles ascribed to him.



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
