- Ministry:** Public Infrastructure and Land Transport (Public Infrastructure Division)
- Post:** Chief Motor/Diesel Mechanic
- Salary:** Rs 18,450 x 375 – 19,575 x 475 – 21,950 x 625 – 23,200 x 775 – 30,175 (25 041 060)
- Effective Date:** 20 June 2016
- Qualifications:** By promotion, on the basis of experience and merit, of employees in the grade of Motor/Diesel Mechanic on the permanent and pensionable establishment of the Ministry who reckon at least eight years' service in the grade and who –
- (i) have good technical knowledge of the trade; and
  - (ii) are able to train and direct Motor/Diesel Mechanics.
- Duties:**
1. To guide, train and supervise Motor/Diesel Mechanics and other workers under his responsibility.
  2. To undertake personally the most complicated work of his trade.
  3. To ensure that the quality and output of work performed are satisfactory.
  4. To ensure that workers comply with safety measures and precautions recommended for the trade.
  5. To submit request for parts/materials through the Workshop Supervisor to the Procurement and Supply section and issue same to Motor/Diesel Mechanics.
  6. To ensure that tools, equipment and materials are judiciously used.
  7. To keep records of progress of work and parts/materials used in appropriate books, job cards and in other forms of data.
  8. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the Chief Motor/Diesel Mechanic in the roles ascribed to him.
