- (iii) possess a valid driving licence (manual gear) for cars, heavy motorcars and goods vehicles; and
- (iv) have a knowledge of First Aid.

NOTE 2

Selected candidates at (a), (b), (c) and under "NOTE 1" will be required to obtain a service driving licence (manual gear) to drive cars, heavy motorcars and goods vehicles.

Candidates should produce written evidence of knowledge claimed.

Duties:

- 1. To carry out
 - (i) necessary measurements and calculations of the trade in accordance with technical specifications; and
 - (ii) servicing and repairs to vehicles, plant and equipment.
- 2. To diagnose faults, dismantle, overhaul, reassemble petrol/diesel engine, gearbox, clutch and mechanical systems (braking, cooling, lubricating, steering, suspension, fuel, hydraulic and pneumatic systems).
- 3. To dismantle mechanical assembly systems for other Tradesmen to carry work in their trade and reassemble, as and when required.
- 4. To assist the Chief Motor/Diesel Mechanic in the procurement of parts required for servicing/repair and in the verification of items received.
- 5. To use correctly the tools, equipment and accessories pertaining to the trade.
- 6. To diagnose simple faults and effect simple repairs of electrical equipment.
- 7. To road test vehicles after repairs.
