SCHEME OF SERVICE SPECIFIED UNDER REGULATION 15 OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION REGULATIONS

Ministry: Prime Minister’s Office (Revenue and Valuation Appeal Tribunal)

Post: Vice-Chairperson

Salary: Rs 102,000 (12 00 96)

Effective Date: 9 October 2014

Qualifications: By selection from among barristers whose names have been entered on and not erased from the Roll of Law Practitioners and who reckon not less than five years’ standing at the Bar.

NOTE 1

The person holding the post of Vice-Chairperson of the Assessment Review Committee prior to the commencement of the Revenue and Valuation Appeal Tribunal Act is entitled to be transferred to the post of Vice-Chairperson of the Revenue and Valuation Appeal Tribunal and remain in office until the expiry of his existing contract pursuant to section 14(3) of the Revenue and Valuation Appeal Tribunal Act 2013.

NOTE 2

The Vice-Chairperson may be called upon by the Public Service Commission to act as Vice-Chairperson of any Tribunal established under any other enactment.

Role and Responsibilities: To assist the Chairperson in the proper functioning of the Revenue and Valuation Appeal Tribunal.

Duties: To perform the duties of his office as laid down in the Revenue and Valuation Appeal Tribunal Act.
