<u>Duties:</u>
1. To assist the Principal Meteorological Observer and Senior Meteorological Observer in the performance of their duties.

2. To perform observations of the elements of the weather according to the World Meteorological Organisation Standards.

3. To read and plot meteorological data from Mauritius network of observations, automatic meteorological transmissions on meteorological charts.

4. To operate radio receivers.

- 5. To archive, retrieve and process meteorological and climatological data.
- 6. To transmit meteorological information to Air Traffic Services for aircraft taking off or landing.
- 7. To operate and carry out simple maintenance of simple electricity generating equipment used at the Meteorological Station.
- 8. To use ICT in the performance of his duties.
- 9. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the Meteorological Observer in the roles ascribed to him.

Note

Meteorological Observers will be required to work on a 24-hour shift system including Saturdays, Sundays, Public Holidays, during cyclonic periods and extreme weather events.
