

**SCHEME OF SERVICE SPECIFIED UNDER REGULATION 15 OF THE  
PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION REGULATIONS**


- Organisation:** Rodrigues Regional Assembly (Fisheries)
- Post:** Senior Fisheries Protection Officer
- Salary:** Rs 13,800 x 400 – 15,000 x 500 – 16,000 x 600 – 22,000 (19 34 49)
- Effective Date:** 10 May 2011
- Qualifications:** By promotion, on the basis of experience and merit, of officers in the grade of Fisheries Protection Officer who reckon at least four years' service in a substantive capacity in the grade.
- Duties:**
1. To be in charge of a Fisheries Post and to control fish landing stations.
  2. To be responsible for the registration of fishing boats and fishermen.
  3. To monitor the attendance of registered professional fishermen.
  4. To prepare and maintain the list of professional fishermen eligible to draw bad weather and close season allowances.
  5. To perform enforcement duties on land and at sea including the landing of fish.
  6. To drive, whenever required, official vehicles for coast patrol and to man patrol boats during afloat patrol.
  7. To supervise and train subordinate staff.
  8. To use ICT in the performance of his duties.
  9. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from Senior Fisheries Protection Officers in the roles ascribed to them.

**Note**

1. Senior Fisheries Protection Officers will be required to work in relays on a 24-hour basis invariably, including night duty and work on Sundays and Public Holidays.
2. Senior Fisheries Protection Officers may be called upon to walk on the seabed up to one meter water level, swim and skin dive.
