- B. Candidates should be computer literate.


Candidates should produce written evidence of knowledge claimed.

- Duties:**
1. To be responsible to the Health Director through the Hospital Administrator for performing the following duties –
- (i) installing, maintaining and repairing plant and equipment;
- (ii) assisting in carrying out regular tests and inspections on plant and equipment;
- (iii) maintaining records and furnishing returns and reports, as may be required;
- (iv) organising the work of subordinate staff; and
- (v) assisting in the preparation of lists of spare parts required for maintenance/repairs of medical equipment.
