In the absence of qualified candidates, by selection from among candidates possessing a Cambridge School Certificate with credit in at least four subjects including French, Mathematics and Physics obtained on one certificate or a General Certificate of Education "Ordinary Level" with passes in at least five subjects including English Language and at least Grade C in four other subjects including French, Mathematics and Physics obtained on one certificate or an equivalent qualification acceptable to the Public Service Commission.

NOTE 2:

Selected candidates will be appointed in a temporary capacity and will be required to undergo on-the-job training for a period of six months in Mauritius, at the end of which, if favourably reported upon, they will be appointed E.C.G Technician in a substantive capacity.

Duties:

1. To be responsible for:
 - (a) calling, receiving and preparing patients for electrocardiogram examination;
 - (b) recording electrocardiographs and writing down necessary data;
 - (c) registering, filing and safe keeping of E.C.G records and placing them at the disposal of medical personnel whenever required;
 - (d) cleaning the electrocardiograph apparatus and accessories; and
 - (e) carrying out normal routine maintenance of electrocardiograph equipment.
2. To perform such cognate duties as may be assigned.
