
Pharmacy Technicians who possess a National Pharmacy Technician Diploma from a recognised institution or an equivalent qualification will be allowed to progress beyond the Qualification Bar (QB) in the salary scale of the post.

- Duties:**
1. To be responsible to the Health Director through the Senior Pharmacy Technician for the following duties –
    - (i) to compound drugs, medicines and prepare sterile pharmaceutical products;
    - (ii) to dispense drugs and medicines at any health institution and give full directions for the use thereof;
    - (iii) to order, receive and issue drugs, medicines, sera, vaccines, sterile products, ingredients, surgical dressings and keep records thereof;
    - (iv) to open and close the dispensing section of the institution;
    - (v) to ensure general tidiness and cleanliness; and
    - (vi) to submit returns as and when required.
  2. To use ICT in the performance of his duties.
