Qualifications: By promotion, on the basis of experience and merit, of officers in the grade of Senior Health Inspector reckoning at least ten years' service in a substantive capacity in the Health Inspectorate Cadre and possessing good communication and supervisory skills.

- Duties:**
1. To be responsible to the Departmental Head through the Health Director for the following:-
 - (a) supervising and coordinating the work of Senior Health Inspectors, Health Inspectors and other junior public health staff under his responsibility;
 - (b) the control and surveillance of communicable diseases and the promotion of environmental health, industrial hygiene and food hygiene;
 - (c) the enforcement of relevant public health legislations including those related to environmental health, occupational health, industrial hygiene, food, trade and industries;
 - (d) liaising with members of the community, local organisations and other health workers to promote health-related activities and healthy life styles in the community;
 - (e) attending committees or meetings and giving assistance in the preparation of public health legislations;
 - (f) implementing health education programmes with special emphasis on hygiene and sanitation and undertaking inspection of food commodities and food premises;
 - (g) assisting in the training of health and other personnel;
 - (h) ensuring that quarantine regulations and disease control measures are complied with;

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- (i) supervising and ensuring the smooth running of public health offices and performing administrative work, including the submission of reports and returns;
 - (j) examining and reporting on building plans for food establishments and plants, and on the storage, transport and distribution of food; and
 - (k) supervising the inspection of abattoirs, including inspection of meat and the inspection of markets and meat shops.
2. To perform such cognate duties as may be assigned.

Principal Health Inspectors may be required to work during weekends, on public holidays and outside normal working hours.



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
