- Qualifications:**
- A. Candidates should –
- (i) be fully registered as medical practitioners in accordance with legislation in force in Mauritius; and
 - (ii) possess a certificate in Sports Medicine awarded by a recognised medical institution and approved by the Medical Council or an equivalent qualification acceptable to the Public Service Commission.
- B. Candidates should –
- (i) reckon one year's practical experience in the field of Sports Medicine after obtention of the qualifications at A(i) and A(ii) above;
 - (ii) have good organising and administrative skills;
 - (iii) have good interpersonal and communication skills;
 - (iv) be customer-oriented; and
 - (v) be computer literate.


Candidates should produce written evidence of experience/knowledge claimed.

Role and Responsibilities: To be responsible for the delivery of quality medical health care services in the sports field.

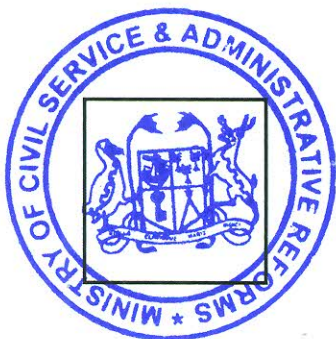

Duties:

1. To be in charge of the Sports Medical Unit, as and when required.
2. To be responsible for the medical examination, assessment of fitness and follow-up of sportsmen referred by Sport Federations and the Ministry.
3. To refer such cases needing investigations and treatment to specialised units and follow them up.
4. To arrange for and participate in health education programmes pertaining to sports medicine.
5. To work in close collaboration with sports coaches.
6. To promote sports medicine in Mauritius.
7. To use ICT in the performance of his duties.
8. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above and related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the Sports Medical Officer in the roles ascribed to him.

Note

Sports Medical Officers will be required to work outside normal working hours including Saturdays, Sundays and Public Holidays.
