Duties:

1. To design, implement, maintain, monitor and secure network solutions, architecture and topologies and propose improvements for the efficiency of existing networks within Government with the assistance of relevant stakeholders.
2. To design, implement, monitor, secure and manage the computer infrastructure of the Central Information Systems Division.
3. To install, configure, monitor and support network equipment to maximise network performance and security.
4. To assist in the procurement of network equipment and accessories and manage suppliers involved with network installation.
5. To advise on the upgrades of computer systems/networks maintained by the Central Information Systems Division staff.
6. To investigate faults reported in the Government ICT networks and propose solutions thereon.
7. To plan, install, secure, maintain, configure, upgrade Operating Systems and hardware infrastructure and carry out performance tuning and hardening thereon with the assistance of relevant stakeholders.
8. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the Network/Systems Infrastructure Analyst in the roles ascribed to him.
