

**SCHEME OF SERVICE SPECIFIED UNDER REGULATION 15 OF THE  
PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION REGULATIONS**

**Ministry:** Public Utilities (Water Resources Unit)  
**Post:** Mason  
**Salary:** Rs 6,275 x 150 – 7,325 x 175 – 8,200 x 200 – 9,000 x 250 – 10,000 x 300 – 10,300 ( 25 12 33)  
**Effective Date:** 1 August 2006  
**Qualifications:** By selection from among serving employees who hold a substantive appointment in the grade of Tradesman's Assistant and have passed the appropriate trade test.

**Note**

In the absence of qualified employees, by selection from among candidates who possess –

- (i) the Certificate of Primary Education; and
- (ii) the National Trade Certificate (Level 3) in the appropriate trade issued by the Mauritius Examination Syndicate and the Industrial and Vocational Training Board or an equivalent qualification acceptable to the Public Service Commission.

**Duties:**

- 1. To carry out the necessary measurements and calculations for the works to be executed in accordance with the technical specifications.
- 2. To mix mortar and concrete, for use for the structures under construction, in accordance with the technical specifications.
- 3. To set out foundations and set levels and square angles accurately.
- 4. To cut and dress stones or bricks for any purpose.
- 5. To build coursed stone walls in correct bond.
- 6. To build walls with the correct use of stone "libages/parpaings" and ensure that the correct joints are made.
- 7. To build walls with concrete blocks and fairfaced rocks.

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8. To prepare walls for concreting.
9. To render in cement surfaces and angles and to lay and trowel cement floors to levels.
10. To train and supervise Tradesman's Assistants and other workers under his supervision.
11. To advise on the use and purchase of materials, tools and equipment, as may be required.
12. To use and keep in good order, all the tools of the trade.
13. To ensure that all operations regarding the use of specific tools and equipment are carried out safely.
14. To carry out works on the basis of plans/designs/drawings/sketches and instructions.
15. To perform such cognate duties as may be assigned.



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
