 - (b) the preparation and updating of the planning, and development of water resources;
 - (c) the identification of additional water resources;
 - (d) carrying out studies/research related to hydrology, hydrogeology and protection of water resources against pollution;
 - (e) the development of hydrological/hydrogeological softwares and models;
 - (f) the preparation of reports related to above studies/research and water quality;
 - (g) updating of Master Plans for water resources;
 - (h) the management of the hydrological/hydrogeological database; and
