- Effective Date:** 03 June 2020
- Qualifications:** A. Cambridge School Certificate with credit in at least five subjects including English Language, French and Mathematics or Principles of Accounts obtained at not more than two sittings or Passes not below Grade C in at least five subjects including English Language, French and Mathematics or Principles of Accounts obtained at not more than two sittings at the General Certificate of Education “Ordinary Level” provided that at one of the sittings, passes have been obtained either (i) in five subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any two subjects or (ii) in six subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any one subject.

Note

Candidates not possessing a credit in English Language at the Cambridge School Certificate will also be considered provided they possess passes in at least two subjects at “Principal Level” and one subject at “Subsidiary Level” as well as the General Paper obtained on one certificate at the Cambridge Higher School Certificate Examinations.

- B. A Cambridge Higher School Certificate or Passes in at least two subjects obtained on one certificate at the General Certificate of Education “Advanced Level”.

OR

Equivalent qualifications to A and B above acceptable to the Public Service Commission.

Qualification at A above should have been obtained prior to qualification at B above.

- C. Candidates should –
- (i) have an aptitude for enforcement duties;
 - (ii) possess communication skills;
 - (iii) have the following minimum physical requirements –

For male candidates

Height: 1 m 70

Chest: 84 cm (normal inspiration)

For female candidates

Height: 1 m 63

- (iv) be computer literate.

Note

On appointment, Traffic Wardens (on roster) will be required to follow an in-service training programme covering the Road Traffic Act and regulations made under the Act pertaining to their duties.

Duties:

- 1. To enforce the relevant provisions of –
 - (a) the Road Traffic (Paid Parking) Regulations;
 - (b) the Road Traffic (Immobilisation of Vehicles) Regulations;
 - (c) the Road Traffic (Parking Offences) Regulations;
 - (d) any other regulations dealing with parking of vehicles; and
 - (e) the Road Traffic Act and regulations made under it relevant to the duties of Traffic Warden (on roster).

2. To issue Parking Notice, Notice to Owner and Fixed Penalty Notice.
3. To prepare case files for submission to the Police for enquiry and prosecution.
4. To keep records of contraventions in respect of Fixed Penalty Notice, parking and other related offences.
5. To attend court in cases of prosecution.
6. To check licences and certificates to be displayed or carried in vehicles as required by the Road Traffic Act or regulations made under the Act and to issue fixed penalty notices for any offence detected.
7. To stop vehicles for the purpose of verification.
8. To use ICT in the performance of his duties.
9. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from Traffic Warden (on roster) in the roles ascribed to him.

Note

Traffic Wardens (on roster) will be required to work on a roster basis according to a plan specifying the commencing times and finishing times of turns of duty which include Saturdays, Sundays, Public Holidays and which may or may not include night duty.
