## **COVID-19 - Reinforcement of Precautionary Measures**

Mauritius has so far successfully managed the COVID-19 pandemic. This is largely attributable to the preparedness and response of all our citizens, public officers and the frontliners. Government was, therefore, able to act with foresight to consolidate our general state of response to address this pandemic.

- 2. Many countries around the world are currently facing a second and third wave of COVID-19. In certain countries, especially Europe, the situation is so alarming that Governments have no alternative than to have recourse to a nationwide lockdown.
- 3. In this context, it is extremely important that all precautionary measures already adopted are strictly observed and reinforced in order to enhance safety at workplaces and protect our population.
- 4. I, therefore, make an appeal to all Supervising Officers to ensure that hygiene protocol, use of face masks, temperature monitoring and social distancing, amongst others, are strictly complied with in all Ministries and Departments.
