## In Service Training Courses/Seminars/Workshops Abroad

As you are aware, paragraph 4.10.10(1) of the Human Resource Management Manual provides that an officer who has been sponsored to follow an in-service training course including attendance in workshops and seminars, should, on resumption of duty, submit to his Supervising Officer a report, in writing, on the basis of given guidelines, on the training and its relevance and usefulness.

- 2. Government has decided that public officers following a training course or attending a workshop/seminar abroad, should submit a report highlighting how the knowledge and new skills acquired would benefit the organization they are serving and also share the knowledge and skills acquired with their colleagues.
- 3. Supervising Officers are, therefore, requested to ensure that officers concerned submit their report as required and necessary arrangements be made with a view to enabling them to make a proper presentation to their colleagues, soon after their resumption of duty.
