Fees to Chairmen and Members of Statutory Boards and Committees

It has been decided that the fees payable to part-time Chairmen of Statutory Boards and Committees be revised as follows with effect from 01 July 2001.

Category	Present Rate	New Rate
A	Rs 9,000 monthly	Rs 12,000 monthly
B	Rs 6,750 monthly	Rs 9,000 monthly
C	Rs 4,500 monthly	Rs 6,000 monthly
D	Rs 675 per sitting subject to a maximum of Rs 2700 in a month	Rs 900 per sitting subject to a maximum of Rs 3600 in a month


The fees payable to Members of Statutory Boards and Committees have been revised from Rs 300 to Rs 400 per sitting.

		<p>(ii) Rs 2.60 per km for mileage over 800 kms.</p> <p>(iii) Rs 2.60 per km for distance which is not considered as official travelling (from residence to office) on days on which officers are required to carry out field duties.</p>
(d)	Mileage allowance (motorcycle)	<p>(i) Rs 1.80 per km.</p> <p>(ii) Rs 1.10 per km for distance not considered as official travelling (from residence to office) on days on which officers are required to carry out field duties.</p>
(e)	Mileage allowance (autocycle)	<p>(i) Rs 1.45 per km.</p> <p>(ii) Rs 0.85 cts per km for distance not considered as official mileage (from residence to office) on days on which officers are required to carry out field duties.</p>
(f)	Travelling allowance payable to officers who use their own means of transport other than car to attend duty	Rs 160 monthly or the amount that would have been refundable by bus for attending duty, whichever is the higher.
(g)	Commuted travelling allowance payable to Police Officers who use their auto/motorcycles on official duties.	Rs 235 monthly.
