**Vacancy at the Organisation for the Prohibition of Chemical Weapons (OPCW)**

The OPCW is inviting nominations for the post of Senior Safety Officer in its Health and Safety Branch.

2. Applicants should, among others, have:-

- (i) a University level degree or equivalent in a relevant scientific discipline (e.g. Chemistry, Occupational hygiene, health and safety, NBC Defense, etc);
- (ii) extensive technical background in chemical weapons/industrial safety is;
- (iii) familiarity with regulations, guidelines, standards and norms concerning occupational health and safety;
- (iv) excellent interpersonal and communication skills;
- (v) ability to plan and organize;
- (vi) problem solving skills;
- (vii) personal qualities including tact, discretion, accuracy and the ability to work harmoniously in a multi-cultural environment;
- (viii) computer literacy;
- (ix) a minimum of 15 years of recent practical experience as a safety officer, including practical experience of health and safety considerations in chemical weapons (CW) environments (detection, protection, decontamination); and
