Adjustment of Salaries of Advisers/Officers on Contract Parastatal Bodies

In accordance with paragraph 11.13 of the 2021 PRB Report, the salaries paid to Advisers/Officers employed on contract should continue to be submitted to the Bureau, through this Ministry for adjustment purposes.

- 2. The Pay Research Bureau has now informed this Ministry that the salaries/allowances presently drawn by certain officers of Parastatal Bodies, which had not been determined/granted by the Bureau, would be revised upon obtention of additional information such as the basis for granting the salaries/allowances, the profile of the contractual officers and the duties performed by them.
- 3. Accordingly, it would be appreciated if the information as per attached proforma for Advisers/Officers on contract of Parastatal Bodies whose salaries have not yet been reviewed by the Pay Research Bureau in the wake of the 2021 PRB Report could be submitted to this Ministry at the following email address mcsarcosunit1@gmail.com by Friday 15 April 2022, at latest.
- 4. Supervising Officers are requested to bring the content of this Circular to the attention of all Heads of Parastatal Bodies falling under the aegis of their respective Ministry/Department.
