Work From Home Scheme

Please refer to Circular Letters No. 32 and No. 39 of 2020 dated 09 May 2020 and 29 June 2020 respectively issued in connection with the Work From Home Scheme.

- 2. Following the initial pilot phase of the implementation of the Work From Home Scheme, this Ministry is planning to come forward with a formal and comprehensive scheme to encourage Officers to avail of that work pattern. In this context, the Ministry is conducting a survey to gauge the effectiveness of the scheme and identify the challenges that need to be addressed to promote the work from home culture in the public sector.
- 3. The form can be accessed on the website of the Ministry at civilservice.govmu.org and will be sent to users of the Government Email Service as well. The deadline for submission of the Work-From-Home Feedback Form is 30 November, 2020
- 4. Government will, on the basis of the outcome of the survey, adopt a more comprehensive policy on the Work From Home Scheme. A Key Performance Indicator (KPI) with regard to its adoption in the Public Service is also being envisaged.
