Duties:

1. To be in charge of a forest section.
2. To be responsible for:-
 - (i) the control of work including the removal of forest produce and the supervision of the labour force in the section; and
 - (ii) the proper and safe custody of stores items under his charge.
3. To assist in the collection and compilation of forest statistics and forest contraventions records.
4. To investigate forest offences.
5. To prosecute offenders in straightforward cases.
6. To patrol State forest lands, nature reserves, mountains, rivers and road reserves within the section and to enforce legislation relating to forestry.
7. To locate rare indigenous and endemic plants and to collect data on the biology of rare plants and specimen for the herbarium.
8. To assist in carrying out ecological work on the flora and fauna.
9. To perform such cognate duties as may be assigned.
