

**SCHEME OF SERVICE SPECIFIED UNDER REGULATION 15 OF THE
PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION REGULATIONS**

- Ministry:** Agro-Industry and Food Security
- Post:** Senior Scientific Officer (Conservation)
- Salary:** Rs 36,575 x 1,200 – 37,775 x 1,500 – 58,775 (19 64 79)
- Effective Date:** 26 May 2015
- Qualifications:** By promotion, on the basis of experience and merit, of officers in the grade of Scientific Officer (Conservation) who reckon at least four years' service in a substantive capacity in the grade and who –
- (i) possess good organising and supervisory skills; and
 - (ii) are able to lead a team of officers.
- Role and Responsibilities:** To be responsible for the supervision and management of research and conservation works.
- Duties:**
1. To assist the Deputy Director, National Parks and Conservation Service in the management of the technical activities of the National Parks and Conservation Service.
 2. To perform research work and disseminate information on conservation activities.
 3. To supervise the work of Scientific Officers (Conservation) and other technical staff working in the National Parks and Conservation Service.
 4. To monitor the execution of research and conservation programmes.
 5. To organise training programmes for subordinate staff.
 6. To monitor and co-ordinate the implementation of conservation projects and ensure the preparation of draft annual reports.
 7. To use ICT in the performance of his duties.
 8. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the Senior Scientific Officer (Conservation) in the roles ascribed to him.
