- (b) experience in conservation work.

Duties:

1. To be in charge of the conservation section and laboratory.
2. To plan, coordinate and conduct the conservation programme of the Mauritius Institute.
3. To direct and supervise technicians in conservation and restoration works.
4. To direct museum staff in handling, mounting, care and storage of objects.
5. To advise on authenticity and conditions of objects being considered for acquisition, loan and exhibition.
