Qualifications: By promotion, on the basis of experience and merit, of officers in the grade of Museum Technician who:-

- (i) possess a Cambridge Higher School Certificate with passes at Principal Level in at least two subjects obtained on one certificate or a General Certificate of Education 'Advanced Level' with passes in at least two subjects obtained on one certificate or an equivalent qualification acceptable to the Public Service Commission; and
- (ii) reckon at least five years service in a substantive capacity in the grade.

Duties:

1. To ensure the day-to-day running of the museums under his control.
2. To catalogue museum objects.
3. To undertake the preparation and mounting of temporary and permanent exhibitions.
4. To perform conservation and restoration work.
5. To be responsible for compiling clear and accurate conservation records.
6. To collect in the field specimens/objects as instructed.
7. To be responsible for the cleanliness and upkeep of the laboratories, tools and equipment.
