Duties: General assistance to the Solicitor-General and deputising for him in his absence. Legal advice to Ministries. Supervision of legal drafting under control of Solicitor-General. Drafting of legislation. Conduct of civil cases. Performance of functions of Ministere Public. Member of the Examination Committee for Attorneys-at-Law. Such other duties as may from time to time be assigned to him by the Solicitor-General.
