Post: Senior State Attorney

Salary: Rs 37,500 x 1,250 - 50,000 x 1,500 - 53,000 (12 65 77)

Effective Date: 1 August 2012

Qualifications: By promotion, on the basis of experience and merit, of officers in the grade of State Attorney who reckon at least three years' service in a substantive capacity in the grade and who –

- (i) possess good communication and interpersonal skills;
- (ii) have sound judgment and a high sense of integrity; and
- (iii) have the ability to work under pressure.

NOTE

In the absence of suitably qualified officers in the grade of State Attorney, by selection from among Attorneys-at-Law whose names have been entered on the Roll of Law Practitioners, who are of at least three years' standing and who possess the qualifications at (i), (ii) and (iii) above.

Duties:

- 1. To act as Attorney-at-Law for the Director of Public Prosecutions or the Commissioner of Police.
- 2. To act as Solicitor before the Courts of Mauritius in all criminal cases where the Director of Public Prosecutions or the Commissioner of Police is concerned.
- 3. To brief law officers in all appeal cases, civil and criminal, motions and matters before the Supreme Court in which the Director of Public Prosecutions or Commissioner of Police is concerned.
- 4. To assist Principal State Attorneys, the Deputy Chief State Attorney and the Chief State Attorney in the exercise of their duties.
- 5. To use ICT in the performance of his duties.
- 6. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the Senior State Attorney in the roles ascribed to him.
