- Qualifications:**
- A. By selection from among officers in the grade of Air Traffic Control Supervisor who reckon at least five years' service in a substantive capacity in the grade.
 - B. Candidates should –
 - (i) have knowledge of national and international requirements relating to the types of air traffic control; and
 - (ii) be familiar with relevant International Civil Aviation Organisation (ICAO) documents.


Candidates should produce written evidence of knowledge claimed.

Role and Responsibilities: To ensure that air traffic control is being carried out in accordance with required standards.

- Duties:**
1. To regularly inspect Air Traffic Control Manuals, Air Traffic Control Training Manuals and other instructions currently in force.
 2. To monitor the standards of Air Traffic Control practices.
 3. To ensure that Air Traffic Control staff are performing their duties in accordance with the required standards.
 4. To carry out investigations as directed.
 5. To report shortcomings, make appropriate recommendations and carry out follow-up actions.
 6. To make recommendations regarding the licensing of Air Traffic Control Officers.



7. To use ICT in the performance of his duties.
8. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the Air Traffic Services Standards Officer in the roles ascribed to him.

Note

1. Air Traffic Services Standards Officers may be required to work outside normal working hours including Saturdays, Sundays, Public Holidays and officially declared cyclone days and during emergencies.
2. Air Traffic Services Standards Officers may be required to follow such theoretical or practical training courses locally or overseas, as may be approved and arranged by the Department.
3. Air Traffic Services Standards Officers may be sent on assignment to Rodrigues or any of the Outer Islands of the Republic of Mauritius.
