NOTE:

For the first intake, priority of consideration will be given to former HMS employees who have been giving assistance at Electrician level.

Duties:

1. To carry out maintenance of underground and overhead power cables.
2. To maintain electrical installation comprising wiring, plugs, sockets, switches, fuses, control panels and such other fittings utilised for the purpose of supplying power, lighting, heating and air conditioning.
3. To maintain electrical parts of systems utilised for providing standby power, fire and other alarm systems, detection equipment and obstruction lights.
4. To carry out such tests as instructed on the electrical installations with a view to determine their serviceability, and to take such precautions as are necessary to ensure that these installations are safe for both the user and the maintenance personnel.
5. To carry out such other tasks that are necessary in the course of normal duties e.g. carrying poles, cables, materials and assisting with their installations.

6. To perform, as and when required, installation and maintenance tasks on poles, masts, towers and such other structure utilised by the department for the purpose of erecting antennas, obstruction lights and airfield lighting.
7. To work on a 24-hour shift system of duty including Sundays, Public Holidays and on declared cyclone days.
8. To perform other cognate duties.
