- I. To be responsible to the Permanent Secretary or any other officer deputed by him for –
 - (a) the planning, co-ordination and supervision of all aspects of work of the Fisheries Protection Service;
 - (b) the planning, implementation and evaluation of the activities of Regional Headquarters of the Fisheries Protection Service; and
 - (c) undertaking re-engineering of the processes at the Fisheries Protection Service, as and when required, implementing reforms which would transform the division into a modern, effective and efficient organisation and ensuring follow-up action thereof.



2. To assist in the preparation of draft legislation relating to fisheries and marine resources.
3. To ensure –
 - (a) the timely and effective implementation of policies pertaining to the Fisheries Sector;
 - (b) the proper enforcement of relevant legislation, regulations and laws relating to fisheries and marine resources; and
 - (c) the collection and compilation of relevant statistics.
4. To liaise with Fishermen's associations and other organisations on matters relating to fishermen welfare and training.
5. To represent the Ministry on Boards and Committees.
6. To be responsible for the implementation of the Performance Management System in the Fisheries Protection Service.
7. To use ICT in the performance of his duties.
8. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the Controller, Fisheries Protection Service in the roles ascribed to him.
