B. **For the Biology Section**

A Cambridge Higher School Certificate with passes at "Principal Level" in Chemistry and Biology obtained on one certificate or Passes in Chemistry and Biology obtained on one certificate at the General Certificate of Education "Advanced Level".

OR

Equivalent qualifications to A and B above acceptable to the Public Service Commission.

C. Candidates should be computer literate.

Candidates should produce written evidence of knowledge claimed.

Forensic Technicians may be required to undergo training as approved and arranged.

**Duties:**

1. To assist the scientific/technical staff at the Forensic Science Laboratory in forensic examination and analysis related to casework.
2. To take adequate measures to ensure good housekeeping in the Laboratory and assist in the maintenance of Laboratory equipment.
3. To assist in –
  - (i) the analysis of scenes of crime;
  - (ii) the implementation and maintenance of quality assurance and quality control; and
  - (iii) research and development related to Forensic Science.
4. To use ICT in the performance of his duties.
5. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the Forensic Technician in the roles ascribed to him.
