<b><u>Qualifications:</u></b>	By promotion, on the basis of experience and merit, of officers in the grade of Forensic Technician who reckon at least five years' service in a substantive capacity in the grade.

Forensic Technologist/Senior Forensic Technologists may be required to undergo training, as may be approved and arranged.

To be responsible to the Principal Forensic Technologist for the organisation of work, supervision, control and training of Forensic Technicians.</li> <li>2. To assist the scientific staff in Forensic examination and analysis related to casework.</li> <li>3. To prepare and submit reports in selected cases assigned and to depone in Court, as and when required.</li> <li>4. To attend scenes of crime.</li> <li>5. To take adequate measures to ensure good housekeeping in the laboratory.</li> <li>6. To assist in – <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) ensuring proper calibration/maintenance of laboratory equipment;</li> <li>(ii) research and development; and</li> <li>(iii) the implementation and maintenance of Quality Assurance and Quality Control.</li> </ol> </li> </ol>
