- Qualifications:**
  - A. A diploma in Home Economics or Home Science or Food Science from a recognised institution or an equivalent qualification acceptable to the Public Service Commission.
  - B. Candidates should –
    - (i) possess good organising, communication and interpersonal skills; and
    - (ii) be computer literate.

Candidates should produce written evidence of knowledge claimed.

- Duties:**
  1. To organise and supervise programmes in Home Economics and related fields for the benefit of women, children and the community at large.
  2. To train junior staff working under his responsibility.
  3. To monitor and supervise the activities at the level of Home Economics Resource Centres.
  4. To conduct such surveys as may be required to facilitate the formulation/design of Home Economics Programmes.
  5. To assist in the organisation of exhibitions, seminars, competitions, conferences and other educational/recreational activities aimed at enhancing the quality of the community.
  6. To implement projects related to the enhancement of food security, the promotion of good health and nutrition as well as the promotion of enterprise development.
  7. To train and reskill laid off workers.


