Qualifications: Candidates must have reached their 20th birthday and, unless already holding a permanent and pensionable post in the Service, should not have reached their 35th birthday by the closing date for the submission of applications. They should be the holders of a Cambridge School Certificate with credit in at least five subjects including English Language, Mathematics, Chemistry and Physics taken at one and the same sitting or an acceptable alternative qualification.

Duties: Registration in the appropriate book of specimens received; supervision of the cleaning and unkeep of glasswares and apparatuses; preparation of solutions; performance of analysis connected with waters, sewage, dairy products, textiles, alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages, fats, oils, waxes, flour, starches, denatured spirits, etc., helping senior members of staff in performing all tests; any other duties which the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Health, may assign.
