- Qualifications: By promotion, on the basis of experience and merit of officers from the grade of Medical Laboratory Technician with at least 4 years' service in the grade.
- Duties:
1. To be responsible to the Chief Medical Laboratory Technician through the Principal Medical Laboratory Technician for:-
 - (i) the day to day running of a minor branch laboratory or a section of the Pathological Laboratory/major branch laboratory;
 - (ii) performing analyses on specimens received and reporting thereon;
 - (iii) preparing culture media, sera vaccines, reagents and standard solutions;
 - (iv) maintaining and taking care of laboratory instruments equipment and glasswares;
 - (v) reporting on the health of Laboratory animal
 - (vi) training and supervising junior staff and trainees;
 - (vii) participating actively in any project where his services may be required;
 - (viii) bleeding, injecting and examining laboratory animals;
 - (ix) ensuring the safety of personnel;
 - (x) taking charge of instruments, equipment and materials required for the day to day running of the Laboratory;
 - (xi) submitting reports on work performed.
 2. To perform other cognate duties.
