**SCHEME OF SERVICE SPECIFIED UNDER REGULATION 15 OF THE  
PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION REGULATIONS**

- Ministry:** Health and Quality of Life
- Post:** Student Radiation Therapist
- Salary:** Rs 9,200 x 200 – 9,600 (09 16 18)
- Effective Date:** 20 March 2012
- Age Limit:** Between 18 and 35 years of age
- Qualifications:** A. A Cambridge School Certificate with credit in at least five subjects including English Language, Mathematics and Physics obtained on one certificate or Passes not below Grade C in at least five subjects including English Language, Mathematics and Physics obtained on one certificate at the General Certificate of Education “Ordinary Level” or an equivalent qualification acceptable to the Public Service Commission.

**Note**

Candidates not possessing a credit in English Language at the Cambridge School Certificate will also be considered provided they possess passes in at least two subjects at “Principal Level” and one subject at “Subsidiary Level” as well as the General Paper obtained on one certificate at the Cambridge Higher School Certificate Examinations.

B. Candidates should be computer literate.

Candidates should produce written evidence of knowledge claimed.

**Training:** Selected candidates will be required to undergo training for a period of at least three years, both theoretical and practical, in all aspects of the work of a Radiation Therapist in Radiotherapy for therapeutic purposes.

On successful completion of the training, which includes passing the final examination and obtaining the Certificate in Radiotherapy issued by the Ministry of Health and Quality of Life, Student Radiation Therapists will be considered for appointment to the grade of Radiation Therapist, as and when vacancies occur.
