- Ministry:** Health and Quality of Life
- Post:** Superintending Dental Surgeon (to be restyled Regional Dental Superintendent)
- Salary:** Rs 57,275 x 1,500 – 58,775 x 1,800 – 69,575 x 2,425 – 72,000 x 2,500 - 77,000 x 3,000 – 89,000 (09 78 92)
- Effective Date:** 24 May 2013
- Qualifications:** By promotion, on the basis of experience and merit, of officers in the grade of Dental Surgeon/Senior Dental Surgeon who –
- (i) reckon at least eight years' service in a substantive capacity in the grade;
  - (ii) have served a tour of service in Rodrigues or the Outer Islands;
  - (iii) have good organising, administrative and management potential;
  - (iv) possess good communication skills; and
  - (v) have the ability to lead and motivate a team of officers.
- Role and Responsibilities:** To be responsible for the administration and delivery of efficient and quality dental services in the Regional Hospital including its annexed institutions.
- Duties:**
1. To be responsible to the Director, Dental Services through the Regional Health Director for –
    - (i) performing dental work and ensuring a quick and efficient service to the public;
    - (ii) organising and managing the dental services of the region for which he is responsible;
    - (iii) supervising the work of all officers in the Dental Cadre working in the region; and
    - (iv) advising and assisting the Regional Health Director and the Director, Dental Services in matters relating to dental care and to the improvement of oral health in the region.
  2. To use ICT in the performance of his duties.
  3. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the Superintending Dental Surgeon (to be restyled Regional Dental Superintendent) in the roles ascribed to him.
