- Duties:** To be responsible to the Senior Health Engineering Assistant for the following:-
1. To assist, as required, in the execution of the functions and activities of the Environmental Health Unit.
  2. To examine applications and drawings for health clearance, carry out site inspections, where appropriate, and submit reports thereon.
  3. To investigate and advise on methods of on-site disposal of both solid and liquid wastes from industries, hotels, etc..
  4. To undertake preliminary engineering surveys with a view to assessing the degree of pollution of the environment and report thereon.
  5. To assist and advise on engineering works for the control of vector-borne diseases and land drainage.
  6. To collaborate with other Public Health teams in the region and with other relevant bodies on engineering matters relating to the environment.
  7. To participate in the implementation of health education programmes in the region.
