By appointment of employees of the Ministry who:-

(a) possess the Certificate of Primary Education (formerly the Primary School Leaving Certificate) or an alternative qualification acceptable to the Public Service Commission; and

(b) reckon at least three years' satisfactory service in the Ministry of Health.

Proven experience in ambulance work will be an advantage.

NOTE:

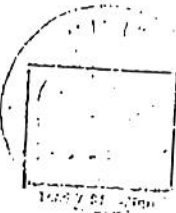
Selected candidates will be required to follow successfully a course in First Aid.

Duties:

1. To handle the sick and the injured and the convalescent who enter and leave an ambulance.
2. To assist in the conveyance of patients to and from an ambulance.
3. To maintain an ambulance in clean condition at all reasonable times both inside and outside.
4. To assist the driver in carrying out simple maintenance tasks and effecting minor repairs in ambulance.
5. To perform such cognate duties as may be assigned.

NOTE:

Ambulance Attendants are required to work on a shift basis, including Sundays and Public Holidays, covering a 24-hour service.
